**Please give a book to the Infant & Junior School Libraries this Christmas!**

As the festive season approaches, we are delighted to announce the launch of a two Honeywell book wish lists on Amazon, one for the Infant Library and the other for the Junior Library. Some of the books on our wish lists are classics, some are popular books requested by the children, some are new titles, some are required to replace damaged books and the rest are simply books we need to fill in gaps in our book collection (ie: when we have a few but not all books in a series). There is a varied selection which should suit all reading levels.

We have made it very easy for you to purchase a book (or two!) for either or both Libraries; one of the ways is a little quicker than the other, but please read on!

You can order directly from Amazon, but if you have time, we would be very grateful if you could consider using one of the following two shopping websites which Honeywell PTFA has joined, [www.thegivingmachine.co.uk](http://www.thegivingmachine.co.uk) or [www.easyfundraising.org.uk](http://www.easyfundraising.org.uk). If you sign up to one or other of these (which only takes a couple of minutes), and then click on the link to Amazon from either site, a percentage of the money from your order will also be given to the school – a double whammy! For specific orders on Amazon, **thegivingmachine** give 3.75% and **easyfundraising** give 2.5%.

The wish lists are accessed via [www.amazon.co.uk](http://www.amazon.co.uk). When you log on either directly to Amazon or via one of the websites above, please click 'Wish List' which appears as a box on the right hand side of the webpage. In the 'Find a Wish List' box on the right, search for 'Honeywell' and this will bring up a number of Honeywells. Please make sure you click the right one (there are over 50 Honeywells)! Once you have found the relevant wish list, you can then browse through the selection of fiction books that we would like for the Infant or Junior Library. Unless otherwise stated, we require 1 copy of each book. Once you have made your selection, and paid via credit/debit card, the books will be delivered to the school. Unfortunately, the name of the donor does not automatically appear on the actual book (although it will appear on the delivery note). However, our library helpers will fill in a book donation label on your behalf (unless you or your child would like to do this individually) to be affixed to the book prior to it being placed in the relevant Library.

A book donation is a wonderful gift for Honeywell's Infant and Junior Libraries and we are very excited about this new venture.
